An adult needs to cut off the top of a carrot and trim off any leaves. Invite the children to place the carrot in a layer of small pebbles that are lined in a flat dish. Pour in water up to the level of the carrot. Make sure to keep the carrot well-watered and encourage the children to watch the green top grow.
