At face value, the concept is quite simple and straightforward: Start by developing a clear picture of what learners should ultimately be able to do successfully at the end of a significant educational experience (i.e., the outcome).

Outcome Based Education. Times are changing. The pressure on our public schools to improve, and change, has become intense. Since 1960 our population has increased by 41%, spending on education has increased by 225% (in constant 1990 dollars), but SAT scores have fallen by 8% (or 80 points).

In Minnesota, the Department of Education's Office of Educational Leadership worked in 10 project sites across the state from 1989 through 1991 to determine the effectiveness of an outcome-based system of education in improving student learning (Minnesota Department of Education 1990, Center for Applied Research and Educational Improvement 1991, Bosma and King 1992).
